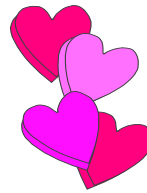

CLASS PLACEMENT - 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR - Garden City Schools take special care in placing children for the coming school year. Our school district is committed to striving for well-balanced, heterogeneous classes, capitalizing on the strengths of the staff and the individual needs of students. Class placement is conducted in collaboration with classroom teachers and administrators.

If there are any particular concerns (i.e. placement in a Nut Sensitive class) you have with your child and his/her placement for the 2010-2011 year, please notify Miss Norton, principal via letter. All letters will be acknowledged in writing. For extenuating circumstances or concerns, you can arrange for a meeting with the principal by calling the secretary at 478-1400 for an appointment. Any concerns should be submitted by Monday, May 3, 2010. All letters received requesting a specific teacher will not be accepted. The final responsibility for a child’s class placement is the building administrator.
